Sub: Higher Education Department – All India Survey on Higher Education – Uploading data for the year 2013-14 and 2014-15 -reg.

In the letter from the Deputy Director General, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of Higher Education, it is informed that the closing date for All India Survey of Higher Education (AISHE) 2013-14 and 2014-15 is 31st October, 2015 and 30th November, 2015 respectively. Since MHRD is planning to launch the survey for the year, 2015-16 in the month of November, 2015 and it would be appropriate to complete the data uploading of the earlier years' survey to avoid confusion by running parallel surveys.
