3. Decision in the review meeting held on 30.12.2015 by Additional Chief Secretary (Higher Education) relating to issue of PF Credit cards and implementation of GAIN PF

ORDER

The Online PF system, GAIN PF (Government Aided Institution Provident Fund) has been implemented in the Government Aided Arts & Science Colleges and Training Colleges under the jurisdiction of Collegiate Education Department from 2011 onwards and the works relating to the same have been entrusted with the Director of Collegiate Education. The purpose of the GAINPF is to maintain and handle the PF Account of the staff of Private Aided Colleges very smoothly and in a transparent way through online system. Government has been conducting periodic review meetings for the successful implementation of the Scheme. As a part of this, many training programmes were conducted for the implementing staff of the Deputy Director's Office and the Colleges. Moreover, a Nodal Officer has also been designated in each college for the successful implementation of the Scheme.

In the periodic review meetings, it has been noticed that the slow progress in the implementation of the Scheme was due to the delay in carrying out the online entries. Hence, Government vide circular read as 1st paper above has instructed that all the Principals of Private Aided Colleges should take immediate steps to complete the entry of details of all staff in their colleges immediately. It was also informed that all the Provident Fund transactions from 01.08.2015, of Staff of Private Aided Colleges will be dealt in online only.

Since it was found that the implementation is till slow, Government has issued another circular read as 2nd Paper above, in which it has been instructed that all applications of staff relating to Provident Fund of Aided Arts & Science/Training Colleges, which have been submitted after 1.8.15 would be resubmitted through online system only, and all Principals of Aided Arts & Science Colleges / Training Colleges, Deputy Directors of Collegiate Education and Director of Collegiate Education were given direction to take immediate steps to ensure that the above decision is implemented strictly.

In the review meeting held on 30.12.2015, the matter was discussed in detail and it was viewed that the slow progress in the implementation of the GAIN PF Scheme is due to the delay in the making the online entry in the software by the Colleges. Government have examined the matter in detail and hereby order that the salary of the Principals of Aided Colleges, who have not completed the data entry process, of all the staff in their Colleges, in the GAIN PF scheme and have not forwarded the same to the concerned Deputy Directors of Collegiate Education, on or before 1.3.2016, will be blocked till they complete the process.
