Additional Guidelines/Clarifications related to implementation of SSP/WWS/ASAP

## Scholar Support Programme (SSP)

- 1. Study materials may be distributed to all the 50 students (Rs.500/- per student). The amount is for the entire academic year. Books may be purchased following the existing procedure.
- 2. External faculty may be engaged for classes wherever found absolutely necessary and in the interest of the students
- 3. The number of subjects may be more than 6 also if necessary and as per the student needs but the total number of sessions (hours) must be limited to the permissible number.
- 4. Students staying away from the classes regularly, may be removed from the Roll and substitute student, permitted to join the scheme.
- 5. Those removed from the Roll in one semester for want of attendance need not be included in the scheme in the second semester.

## Walk With a Scholar (WWS)

- (1. Coordinator should not function as an Internal Mentor.
- 2. Training will be imparted to the Coordinators also.
- 3. Internal Mentors of an Institution should not function as External mentor of another Institution.
- 4. The clause related to the assigning of 5 students to each External Mentor and the number of External Mentors (6) need not be insisted. However, the total number of sessions for the External Mentors (30) should be ensured.
- 5. Students staying away from the classes regularly, may be removed from the Roll and substitute permitted to join the scheme.
- 6. Those removed from the Roll in one semester for want of attendance need not be included in the scheme in the second semester.
- 7. Books may be purchased following the exiting procedure.
