Higher Education Department- Release of 3rd and 4th installments of 6th UGC Pay Revision- Amount held back from release to teachers for want of settlement of excess amount drawn towards remuneration of answer scripts- Exemption granted - Orders issued.

ORDER

As per the Government Orders read as first and second papers above sanction was accorded for the release of 3rd and 4th installments respectively of the 6th UGC Pay Revision Arrears due to the College/University Teachers.

2.The Accountant General, Kerala in the audit report has pointed out that the teachers availed excess remuneration from Universities for valuation of answer scripts of regular students, which must have been performed as part of their normal duty , as per the guidelines issued by UGC. Hence it was incumbent upon the State to recover the excess amount from the arrears due to teachers and it was ordered to release only 80% of the 4th installment of the arrears and to hold back the remaining 20% of the amount ordered for release as per Government Order read as third paper above.

3. As per the order read as fourth paper above, Government have relaxed the restriction, on releasing 20% of the amount of arrears due to College/University teachers on account of third and fourth installments of sixth UGC Pay Revision arrears ordered in the Government Order read as third paper above in the case of Dr.V.Raju, Associate Professor (Retired), Government College, Kariavattom, since he belonged to the Physical Education Department and as such he was in no way entrusted to valuation of answer scripts of students.

4. Now Government are pleased to relax the restriction, on releasing 20% of the amount of arrears due to College/University teachers on account of third and fourth installments of sixth UGC Pay Revision arrears ordered in the Government Order read as third paper above to all similarly placed teachers belonging to the Department of physical Education who were in no way engaged /obliged to be engaged to the evaluation of answer scripts of students.

5. The Director of Collegiate Education shall approve the bill pertaining to all such release and the Treasury Officer concerned shall in turn honour the bill for payment.
